Lily Hirsch

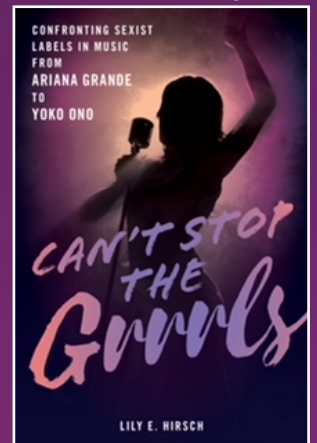
